Guidance Notes

The General Teaching Council for Northern Ireland

The GTCNI is the independent regulatory body for the teaching profession in Northern Ireland and is dedicated to enhancing the status of teaching and promoting the highest standards of professional conduct and practice.

Do I need to register?

The Education (NI) Order 1998 requires that all teachers working in grant-aided schools need to register with the GTCNI, even if you work, or intend to work, on a substitute/supply or peripatetic basis.

How do I register?

To register with the GTCNI you must hold such qualifications as are approved by the Council for the purposes of registration and must not be barred from teaching by the Department of Education, GTCNI, or any of their equivalents in England, Scotland and Wales.

In order for us to carry out an assessment of your eligibility to register we ask that you complete the attached application form and return it together with all necessary supporting documentation.

Unfortunately online registration is not available.

Filling in the application form

- Part 1 should be completed by the applicant.
- Part 2 should be completed by Initial Teacher Education/Training Institution.
- Use black ink only.
- Write clearly in BLOCK CAPITALS.
- Ensure all relevant sections have been completed.
- Sign and date where indicated.
- Use a separate sheet to provide any further relevant information if required.
- Write dates in full numbers e.g. 5th April 2004 should be written as:

- Make sure you complete the application checklist.

Assessment/Registration Fee
